



Assessor Course

One to one, group sessions, face to face, or live online delivery

Who is it for?

The Level 3 Award or Certificate in Assessment is designed for those who are new to assessment, hoping to become assessors, and those who need to know about assessment but never intend to practice – for example managers – could take Unit 1 'Understanding the Principles and Practices of Assessment' to learn about the essential principles and practices of their training staff's roles.

The qualification is suitable for individuals who:

Assess regulated qualifications or non-regulated programmes and who require a qualification in assessing. For those assessing competence-based qualifications the Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment may be a requirement. Alternatively, for those assessing in a non-work environment such as a college workshop, or classroom situation may choose the Award in Assessing Vocationally Related Achievement. If you assess in both environments (on apprenticeships for example) you may need the Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement.

How is it delivered?

The qualifications include up to three units (dependent on course selected)

Unit 1 Understanding the principles and practices of assessment

Unit 2 Assess occupational competence in the work environment

Unit 3 Assess vocational skills, knowledge and understanding

The qualification is delivered by a qualified assessor, live online, or via tailored classroom sessions where you will obtain the knowledge, skills, and reading needed to complete each unit. Resources have been designed to take you through each step of the programme in a logical way. Practical units are assessed in the workplace or learning environment (dependent on the course selected).

Option 1 Live online is our web-based platform where you can engage with your qualification assessor at a time to suit you (including evenings and weekends).

Option 2 Classroom delivered sessions for face to face engagement and learning. Designed to be a focussed, bespoke and fun learning experience.

To undertake the qualification you will require access to a minimum of 2 candidates you can assess on a minimum of 2 occasions (4 assessments in total).
